Three types of need-based scholarships are accessible via this form:

- **DIS Scholarship:** range from \$500 - \$5,000 per semester, and maximum \$250 - \$1,000 per summer based on the duration of your session(s)
- **Diversity Scholarship:** DIS seeks to promote a diverse student body by providing financial support to students from populations traditionally underrepresented in study abroad including those from diverse ethnic, racial, cultural, economic, sexual orientation and educational backgrounds and first generation college students. Diversity Scholarships are available up to \$5,000 per semester and maximum \$250 - \$1,000 per summer based on the duration of your session(s)

Note: The The Jacob Buksti Memorial Scholarship and the Anders Uhrskov Leadership Scholarship are merit-based and use a different application process. Please visit DISabroad.org/scholarship for more information.

You are welcome to apply regardless of your admission status. Complete applications will be reviewed and awardees notified via email within two weeks. Scholarships are normally awarded as a credit toward DIS fees, and may not be used to cover your deposit. Scholarships are not intended to reduce the financial aid package from your institution; however, it is your responsibility to report any awards to your financial aid office. Applications submitted after the deadline will be considered if funds are available.

Scholarships may be combined, but **the maximum total for any student is typically \$5,000.**
